The other chapters give a detailed behind the scenes look at how Viper transformed itself in the wake of Chrysler's bankruptcy and still managed to revamp and realign itself in a changed world. The Generation V Viper incorporates some new technologies and ideologies while retaining the original mandate of Viper -- to be a world-class driver's performance car.
