A good, funny, fast read, that is great for anybody hoping to learn about this fascinating actor's upbringing, his family, his stage experience and start in show business, and, most notably, the whole debacle surrounding Charlie Sheen's 'meltdown', and subsequent exit from the "Two And A Half Men" CBS tv show. In fact, I enjoyed it so much, I ended up tearing through it in just a matter of days, MUCH quicker than the amount of time it normally takes me to get through a good book. HOWEVER, to anyone interested, think twice about purchasing it if you are hoping for an in-depth look, or tons of detailed information regarding his "Two And A Half Men" tv show (outside of Sheen's messy exit, which is covered EXTREMELY well), or the major film that first brought Jon Cryer to most people's attention, "Pretty In Pink" (as Phil "Duckie" Dale). As enjoyable as this book was, that is the one MAJOR drawback.......the fact that Jon Cryer expends almost NO effort at all giving his readers any significant background or depth on these two, very notable projects of his ("TAAHM" and "Pretty In Pink"). For instance, regarding "Pretty In Pink", we learn that he got along very well with the film's director (Howard Deutch), his co-stars James Spader and Harry Dean Stanton, but, surprisingly, did NOT have a great relationship with either Molly Ringwald, or Andrew McCarthy.
