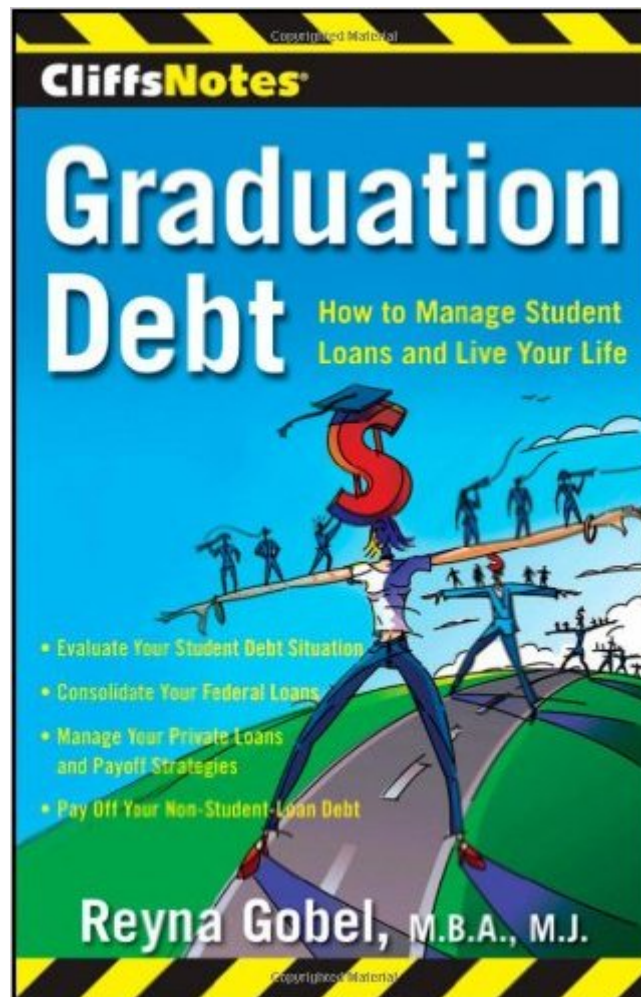

The author gives concise information about how to consolidate and which loans to repay first. This is basically a recap of most common-sense principles of loans and debt management. I was expecting some tips or tricks, but all I got was a rehashing of everything you can find online in 5 minutes. This book was very helpful in explaining not only how to manage debt but also create (and stick to!) a workable budget.
